

INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

January–May, 2019

TITLE: Intern, Creative Leadership Program (two positions available)

LOCATION: Milwaukee, Walker's Point

Open to creatives who already practice a craft — design, art, music, writing, film, etc. — and who plan to work for themselves or start their own business in the future.

This position is designed more like a mentorship than an assistantship. It's part of our Creative Leadership Program — a really special opportunity for young creatives to learn entrepreneurial skills, especially the business side and how to brand themselves as an artist. Our goal is for interns to walk away with knowledge and connections rarely offered through schools or traditional internships — things they can benefit from immediately. It's also our goal to help nurture the next generation of fearless creative leaders who are committed to creating a safer, more equitable and inclusive industry for everyone.

College enrollment not required. U.S. Citizenship not required. And yes of course this is open to men and non-binary folks, not just women.

WHAT YOU CAN LEARN:

- + Brand strategy and development
- + Budgeting and contract negotiation
- + Art activism strategies / using creativity as a force for positive change
- + Public speaking
- + Design basics
- + Project management
- + How personal wellbeing and self awareness = professional success

RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- + Creative concepting and writing
- + Brand research and development
- + Creating proposals and budgets
- + Photography and/or videography
- + Assistance with art installations and/or events
- + Final capstone presentation to community leaders

HOURS AND PAY:

- + Term: mid-January–mid-May, 2019
- + One 5-hour shift in the studio + 3 hours of work on your own time = 8 hours/week
- + There may also be a few times we ask you to work a couple hours outside of your normal schedule at an event, which would count toward weekly hours
- + \$1,000 stipend paid in monthly installments of \$250/mo

- + are currently a practicing creative, of any medium.
- + have a serious interest in being an entrepreneur or already are one.
- + want to be a leader in your field at large.
- + are committed to helping create a safer, more equitable and inclusive industry.
- + want to grow your talents so you can change the world someday, not just sell it more shit it doesn't need.
- + are ambitious and responsible. (These are the ONLY things we can't and won't teach.)
